2024 MCEA Legislative Priorities

Expand the School Age Care Levy to include three and four year old programming. This change would provide out of school childcare support for families with children from Early Childhood through Grade 6 and specifically would cover the **additional costs needed to serve three and four year old children** with disabilities or who are experiencing temporary family or related problems who participate in the school-age care program.



Appropriately fund Early Childhood Preschool Programming to meet the diverse needs of Minnesota families and the delivery costs of a district's defined model.



Establish an ongoing funding stream for unemployment insurance.

Clarify the Adults with Disabilities statute to align with other existing Community Education funding approval and reporting processes.
